Bio: Katherine Morris is a research scientist on the Demography and Survey Science team at Facebook. She works on web surveys that inform decisions both within and outside Facebook, with a focus on survey measurement strategies for machine learning ground truth. Katherine received her BA in sociology from the University of Chicago and her MA and PhD in sociology from Harvard University. At Harvard, she was a graduate affiliate at the Institute for Quantitative Social Science and a research fellow at the Center for Population and Development Studies. Her graduate work used quantitative and qualitative methods to explore the association between health and the larger social contexts in which individuals are embedded, including network structures, neighborhoods, and policy settings. Prior to Harvard, she worked at NORC at the University of Chicago where she was the project coordinator for the National Social Life, Health, and Aging Project and supported numerous other projects within the Population Research Center and the Center on the Demography and Economics of Aging. She has published in journals such as *Social Science & Medicine*, *Journal of Epidemiology and Community Health*, *Journals of Gerontology, Series B: Psychological and Social Sciences*, and *Field Methods*.
